This funding will be used to

- Implement school wide Teach Like a Champion classroom systems and routines to promote consistency of Pedagogical Practices and improve student Level of Achievement from Semester 1 to Semester 2.
- Improve teacher capability and advance leadership through the development of a Collegial Engagement Framework in order to achieve 75% of students reading at or above age appropriate benchmarks by end of year.
- Employ highly skilled professionals to promote student engagement through strengthening Positive Behaviour for Learning Framework (PBL) and additional intervention and support processes.
- Improve effective analysis and use of data through implementation of school wide Data Literacy Framework to improve student tracking and intervention.

Our initiatives include

- Literacy Continuum mapping and PLD Structured Synthetic Phonics approach employed to identify, monitor and support students literacy development.
- High performing teachers and para professionals employed to promote student engagement.
- Implementation of school wide systems and rountines that align to Teach Like a Champion, Positive Behaviour for Learning, Zones of Regulation and student wellbeing.
- QELi and CLaW teams engaged to provide professional development on Teach Like a Champion,
 Positive Behaviour for Learning, Zones of Regulation and wellbeing.
- Conduct visits to other high performing schools that are engaging in Teach Like a Champion to consolidate Teach Like a Champion Pedagogical Approach

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Continue the use of Teach Like a Champion and Positive Behaviour for Learning.
- Providing professional development opportunities for all staff (Teachers and Teacher Aides) in whole school approaches including TLAC, PBL, PLD and Zones of Regulation.
- Make use of local school partnerships for coaching and feedback opportunities with new and existing staff.
